- 1. Report on recent activities: We staffed a table at the RiverWoods volunteer fair and signed up 15 new people to our mailing list. The RiverWoods residents had some ideas for us, including restarting library visits to their campus at which they could sign up for library cards. Hope says that indeed the library will be resuming visits to RiverWoods in early 2023 and that residents will be able to obtain library cards at those visits. - 3. New treasurer: Dottie Cieslewicz has volunteered to be our new treasurer. She has met with our outgoing treasurer and is familiar with the computer programs, forms and duties. We welcome Dottie and say a huge "Thanks" to Susan Scales who has organized our group's finances so well! See below for our latest financial report.
- 4. Future activities: Carla will ask several local businesses if we can partner with them on a fundraiser in 2023. Possibilities include Community Oven, Flatbread Pizza, Otto's Pizza, Water St Books and the Brook casino in Seabrook. Sarah will investigate whether we can have a table at oun of the indoor farmers markets this year. The cribbage group will take December off and schedule their next meeting in January. We talked about bringing back the "Donate a Book" program next summer/fall in anticipation of holiday gift giving.
