

Video to Digital Converter

Video2Digital Converter 3.0



This device will let you convert video and audio sources to digital format.

The source data can be from VHS, Hi8, and camcorder players, retro gaming systems, cassette players, turntables, and more. It takes in any composite video (yellow) or stereo audio (red and white) inputs, and records to a USB Drive or a MicroSD Card. *This item can be checked out from the Library of Things*

CD/DVD Drive



This device will let you read data from CDs or DVDs. You can also record data

(or 'burn') data to these discs. It connects to a computer using a USB cable. Note that this device will not play Blu-ray or 4K Blu-ray discs, only CDs and DVDs.

Photo Scanner

<u>Epsom FastFoto FF-680W</u> <u>Wireless High-Speed Photo</u> <u>Scanning System</u>

This device will let you view and scan printed photos to a digital format. It is wireless and very efficient.



The photos you scan can be up to seven inches (7") wide, and of any length.

Digital Film & Slide Scanner

Kodak Slide N Scan Digital Film Scanner



This scanner allows you to view and digitize photo negatives that are in a slide format.

You can view negatives of sizes 135 (3:2 ratio), 110 (4:3), and 126 (1:1), as well as 50mm Slides. While viewing, you can edit aspects of the image like brightness, red-eye, and contrast before saving to a digital file.

Film Digitizer

Kodak Reels Film Digitizer

This device will let you convert film reels to a digital format.



The source footage can be from either 8mm film reels or Super 8mm film reels. The digitized footage records onto an SD Card. This device can also be used to view film footage.

Microfilm Reader

Canon Microfilm Scanner 400

This device will let you view and make copies of microfilm files. This includes the Library's collection of the Exeter News-Letter.



Camcorder

SONY Handycam

This is a media player for Digital8 tapes. This can be used with the DVD recorder to turn your videos into DVDs.
